When it comes to agronomy we offer soil sampling. We have been using a program to mark the sample points even in a composite situation. What this allows us to do is come back to the same point year after year and sample the same points. We also do sampling for VRT. All this is done under our YieldPoint precision Ag platform through our Agellum app.

We also do tissue sampling in season for producers who are active in CSP programs or simply want to make that in-season foliar pass with a fungicide or other various situations.

We offer strip-till application of dry fertilizer which has been gaining popularity throughout the last couple seasons. Our equipment of choice has been the Soil-Warrior made by (ETS) Environmental tillage systems. Some of the many benefits include: water management, Air induction, residue management, and fertilizer incorporation. The idea is to create an optimal moisture and temperature zone come spring while leaving a portion of standing residue. It places the fertilizer in a 6-8 inch zone and leaves the other 22-24 inches undisturbed.

Also we have the standard dry broadcast applicators “floaters” as well as two dry rogator machines that allow us to apply dry product in –crop. We can apply a single product or up to as many as 4 and Variable rate with the same machine

On the liquid side of things we have liquid rogators we use season long to apply pre-plant all the way through the season in all types of situations including nitrogen application.

Last but not least we have access to aerial methods of application for all types of crops
